

PANDEMIC AID

FOR FOSTER YOUTH

& ALUMNI (age 14-26)



A NEW LAW has passed that provides additional Education and Training Voucher (ETV) funding to help current and former foster youth through the COVID pandemic.



Higher Education \$\$ - the annual ETV limit is temporarily raised to \$12,000 (based on need).



Cash assistance to cover basic needs and other expenses (supplies, equipment, accessories) to help you be successful in your education or training program. Must apply separately.



Extended access! Remember to file your FAFSA and ETV application - those are your keys to the ETV funds

Re-enter college/training program, it's not too late! If you had to "stop out" due to COVID you can re-enroll Spring or Summer Term and have the support you need to be successful.
